Re: Payment of Costs Awarded by Independent Review Panel in ICM Registry, LLC vs. ICANN

Dear Rod,

As you know, pursuant to ICANN's Bylaws Article IV, Section 3(12), the Independent Review Panel determined that ICM was the prevailing party in the recent proceedings and therefore directed ICANN to bear all costs of the IRP provider. (See Declaration of the Independent Review Panel, February 19, 2010, at paragraph 152.)

Therefore, ICM hereby requests that, in compliance with the Panel's declaration, ICANN's own Bylaws, and Rule 9 of the Supplementary Procedures for the IRP, ICANN reimburse ICM the sum of \$241,372.46, representing the amount of fees and expenses previously paid by ICM. ICM requests that payment be made without further delay, to be received by ICM no later than seven days from the date of this letter. Assuming payment is made within seven days, ICM will forego the interest accumulated from the date of the Panel's declaration.
